All motorcycle expedition(s) displayed on our website are operated by Purebiketours (PBT) - 10 Wesley Street, Annesley Woodhouse, Nottinghamshire NG17 9HJ UK. Our motorcycle adventures journey to remote and inaccessible places through developing regions and despite our painstaking planning; you can expect to encounter the unexpected.

Financial Security

As required by law, under The Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992 and the European Directive 90/314/EEC. In association with "International Passenger Protection Limited" (IPP) – all Participants (including International) booking with Purebiketours have full financial protection in the event of our insolvency. You participate with PBT knowingly as a competent rider and do so entirely at your own risk, understanding that motorcycle touring on and off-road involve certain amount of risk and you need to have the openness and the ability to adapt to your environment. Riding through developing countries - besides the terrain - challenges of extremity will be prevalent. PBT or our staff or suppliers will not be held responsible injury to you from your own actions of irresponsibility. PBT reserve the right to decline any booking at their discretion. **This waiver & release forms part of these booking conditions.**

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CONTRACT

Purebiketours (PBT) is the operator of all motorcycle expeditions shown on our website. PBT is registered with Anderson & Co. Accountants Ltd, 18 Diamond Ave, Kirkby in Ashfield, Nottinghamshire NG17 7GR United Kingdom.

In respect of these Booking Conditions, "We/Purebiketours/PBT" and "You/Participant(s)" - will be the person(s) whose name and details appear on the online booking form.

1. Booking

- a) These conditions of contract
- b) The specific itinerary for the motorcycle expedition on which you have booked
- c) Along with the online booking along and Participant(s) deposit(s) clearing at PBT bank will constitute the entire contract binding between PBT and the Participant(s). It will also be taken Participant(s) have read and understand these booking conditions.

2. Payment

2.1) Payments can be made by cheque in the name of Purebiketours and must be sent to; Purebiketours, 10 Wesley Street, Annesley Woodhouse, Nottinghamshire NG17 9HJ. Participants' wishing to make payments by bank

(including International) transfer or online bank transactions; we will forward you PBT bank details separately.

2.2) A non-refundable deposit of £500 per person must accompany your online booking, plus any single supplement requested.

2.3) Balance payment(s) are due 10 weeks before departure date. If booking within 10 week period expedition start – full costs are due.

3. Accommodation (2 people per room)

Accommodation stay is in clean comfortable hotels, guesthouses and camping. In Ladakh we have options of hotel and Leh-homestay. All accommodation is on same sex twin-sharing (couples double-room). Sometimes there might a single occupancy in a double room. Optional: 5star Hotels are available on arrival and departure. P.O.A. Single room is available on request and single supplement will apply.

4. Expedition Costs

All expedition costs are specific as displayed on our website and are effective as of time of display and inclusive of all items mentioned in the expedition inventory. However, if unforeseeable factors such as country currency fluctuation or local Government levy may render PBT to increase our costs as proportionate in line with those fluctuations. If the increase is more than 10% of the expedition costs. Participant(s) will have the right to cancel their expedition with a full refund.

5. Cancellation (By Participant)

The Participant acknowledges that payment for the expedition is an intrinsic part of the expedition's income and contributes to the overall cost of planning, equipment, administration etc and that PBT will have incurred a good part its costs before the actual date of departure.

Cancellation by Participant must be in writing and made by the person who filled the online booking form. However, cancellation charges will be imposed as following:

- 10 weeks or more prior to departure - loss of deposit
- 10 weeks before departure 30% of tour cost
- Less than 10 weeks - 100% of expedition cost

No refunds given if a person/s leave a tour en-route.

Our tours are planned several months in advance to avoid adverse weather conditions. However, changes will be made (en-route) if unfavourable weather hampers our progress. However, while on en-route should any unforeseeable situations arise beyond our control, e.g. landslides, snowpack, earthquake or glacier movement, and as safety of all our riders is paramount, we will make changes to detour to continue with the adventure. Participants' should take out travel insurance which covers cancellation.

6. Cancellation by us

We would normally not cancel an expedition. But we reserve the right to cancel if insufficient numbers of Participants make the expedition commercially unfeasible. If the need arises, all Participants will have the choice to either change to another expedition or a full refund.

7. Your Responsibility

7.1) Participants' booking is accepted on the understanding that they realise the risks and hazards associated with motorcycle activities include personal injury, physical exertion, risks associated with altitude and inconvenience when travelling through remote areas, and knowing that access to evacuation may not be readily available. You accept and consent to the personal risks inherent in the implementation of this Contract and, accept the limitations of PBT liability set out herein as being reasonable.

7.2) If any Participant(s) prior to booking have a medical condition or have to use prescribed medication that we should know about. It is the Participants' duty to notify us beforehand and is their responsibility to obtain relevant medical advice as regards to vaccinations required for the expedition destination.

7.3) Documents - as a guide; all Participants' must bring with them the following paperwork without which PBT may refuse them from joining their expedition:

- Passport with six months clear remaining
- Visa for expedition destination country
- Full motorcycle/driving licence from your country of residence
- International driving licence
- Vaccination certificate
- Personal travel insurance (copy should be brought on travel)

7.4) In alliance with your expedition booking with PBT you agree to give authority to your expedition leader during your travels, where decisions may be needed for the benefit and safety of everyone.

7.5) Insurance - as a condition of joining our Himalayan/India expeditions, you are responsible for your travel insurance and that you are covered against following: Trip cancellations and delays, full medical – accidental cover including repatriation, general liability – loss of luggage. Motorcycle cover is included in your costs.

7.6) **Health & Safety** we take very seriously. Your expeditions traverse heights of 5000m. With two acclimatisation camp stops at 4000m, altitude sickness at these heights may cause some discomfort. However, we take great care of those susceptible to such problems and make sure immediate action is taken. For general health advice and inoculations, please consult your GP. **Please inform us about any medical condition which you may have.**

8. Booking Transfer

Any Participant wishing to transfer a booking to another person may do so on the strict understanding that PBT will ask for written notice of the same and that the new

Participant is under obligation to provide PBT with the necessary details and information as required and all booking conditions will apply to the transferee. Administration charges of £150 will be applicable for the new transaction.

9. Our Responsibility

9.1) It is our duty to ensure we deliver the expedition you have booked with us to the best of our ability and that it precedes in accordance with the itinerary as stated on our website, thereafter making sure as reasonable as possible your journey is unhindered en-route. Our itineraries have been designed with consideration to the locations we travel and its people. Participants' should therefore realise that hygiene and safety standards in countries in which we journey are far different to the standards of our own. However, PBT take care when booking locations, should offer the best of the area in which our riders stay and dine.

9.2) Any Participant(s) portraying acts of negligence on the expedition will not only risk their own life, but also that of their fellow riders and will be cautioned. Repeated actions of Participant(s) in question will have their expedition terminated immediately and no refunds will be given. No refunds will be given to participants who leave an expedition en-route. PBT will not be held responsible for any traffic accidents caused through carelessness.

9.3) Due to the nature of our motorcycle adventures and their locations - PBT reserve the right if deemed necessary, to divert the course of an already commenced expedition away from events (deemed harmful) to the safety of an alternative route.

9.4) Force Majeure – if for any unforeseeable reason interruptions cause delay(s) en- route, preventing PBT from fulfilling their expedition obligations. Any additional expenditure incurred during the interruptions will have to be borne by the participant(s). However, we will do our utmost (within our power) to rectify the situation into continuing on with the adventure.

10. Complaints

PBT endeavours to supply you with the best possible service on your journey, ensuring you have a great time. However, if you have a complaint during your expedition, please notify your expedition leader immediately in order to rectify the situation. If your complaint was unresolved, then a written letter should be sent within 25 days from expedition completion date to: Purebiketours, 10 Wesley Street, Annesley Woodhouse, Nottinghamshire NG17 9HJ United Kingdom.

11. Law & Jurisdiction

The Contract shall be construed in accordance with English law and the parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts to settle any disputes, which may arise out of or in connection with this Contract.
